**SUPPLIES:**



- Corrugated cardboard.  
Cut from a cardboard box.

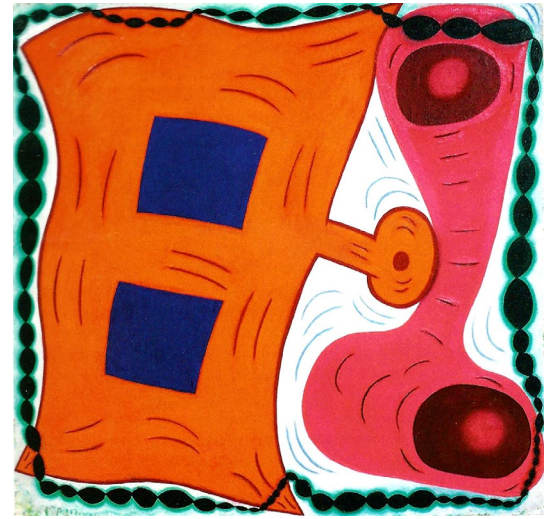
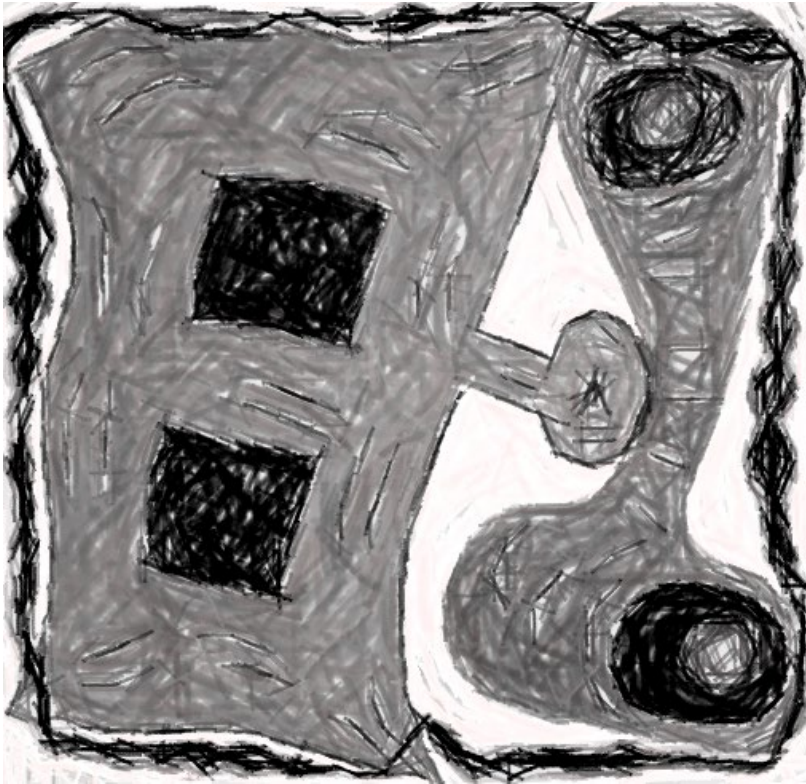
- Markers for coloring in shapes\* Wax pastels (crayons) or colored pencils if you do not have markers.
- Pencil (lead or whatever you prefer for sketching and shading)\*
- Scissors
- Craft / utility knife (Exacto)
- Adhesive – all-purpose glue or paste\*
- Mounting paper – medium weight, such as, cardstock or watercolor or Bristol board. White is universal but any color can be used (if you do not have medium weight paper you can use one of the pieces of corrugated cardboard)\*
- A cutting mat or other surface to cut on, such as piece of cardboard or kitchen cutting board.
- Tweezers (optional)
- Fine grit sandpaper (optional) – small 2x2+ inch piece

**WORK SPACE:** A flat surface where you are comfortable creating, such as, your kitchen table or work bench. Cutting mat if available.

*\*I use the following materials: Prismacolor markers dual tipped (fine and chisel/thick), Golden's gel medium with a brush as applicator, Strathmore 140 lb watercolor paper, a black Sharpie for outlining and adding details, and a black Stabilo-All Pencil for shading.*

*I sometimes use acrylic paint. If using acrylics, you will need a small brush(es) and a heat gun or hair dryer (to help the paint dry quicker), a cup of water and paper towels or a rag for cleaning the brushes as you switch colors (or a paint brush for each color). For this project, any body – heavy or fluid body paints are fine, you can even use latex house paint.*
