WORK AREA

Set out your tools on a sturdy table or area with good lighting where you will be relaxed and comfortable. It is helpful to have an additional flat space to set components aside when not in use or to set objects to dry. Access to water for clean up or pre-moistened wipes. A bowl or jar of water to soak your glue brush when not in use.

SUPPLIES

***asterisked items are included in kit.**

Bone Scorer or old credit card

Rubber Brayer / Roller or old credit card

Craft / Exacto Knife or Scissors

Cutting Mat

Disposable Gloves (optional)

Pencil

Ruler

Wipes and/or paper towels or old rag for clean-up

Brick or rock to weight down book while drying.

*All Purpose PVA Glue

*Awl (or pin tool or needle or carpentry nail)

*Bookbinding / Tapestry Needle

*Brush to apply glue.

*Clips or Clamps – such as binder clips or small craft clamps

*Paper – supplied in the kit are 20 sheets of 5 ½" x 8 ½" 110 lb. (180 g/m²) mixed media paper.

*Parchment or Plastic Wrap or scrap paper to protect surfaces when gluing.

*Scrap Paper – such as from an old book or printer paper at least 10 sheets, any size but we will be using.

*Waxed Thread

*Card Stock or Chip Board

Book A cover: 2 sheets 5 ½" x 4 ¼"

Book B cover: 2 sheets 5 ½" x 3"

*Decorative Paper for covers: at least ½ -1" larger than Chip Board

Book A cover: 2 sheets 6 ½" x 5 ¼"

Book B cover: 2 sheets 6 ½" x 4"
